**Child Abuse Services Named in Honor of Women Philanthropists**



The Violence Intervention Program (VIP) was honored to host a special reception to recognize members of the Everychild Foundation, which awarded a \$600,000 grant to the VIP earlier this year. The Everychild Foundation was a major contributor in the VIP's capital campaign to build a family advocacy center. In recognition of the foundation's generous grant, the VIP celebrated the renaming of its child abuse program as the Everychild Foundation Center for the Vulnerable Child.

The Everychild Foundation is made up of women who pay membership dues of \$5,000 a year. Each year the total of the dues are awarded to one non-profit group selected by a vote of all members. Membership continues to grow and currently there are over 150 members.



Everychild Foundation members had the opportunity to tour the building and speak with staff members about the treatment and protection of children.

The Center for the Vulnerable Child, now named in honor of the Everychild Foundation, was established in 1984 and remains the largest child abuse center in California. By working closely with law enforcement, social services and the legal system, this program ensures that abused and neglected children are appropriately evaluated and treated. The center has been recognized locally, nationally and abroad for its pioneering efforts in the field of child abuse and now this renowned program will carry with it the name of the Everychild Foundation.
